#### SUMMARY

Imago GG India Pvt. Ltd is looking for a Senior Associate to support the design and implementation of the training & capacity building plan under the project, scaling of women-led agro-processing enterprise model through the community institutions of NRLM is currently being implemented across Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, and Jharkhand.

The Capacity Building Senior Associate will be responsible for working on the successful design, strategy, coordination, and delivery of the training and capacity building plan for the key stakeholders, particularly self-help group

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women, as part of the scaling-up of the agro-processing enterprise model. The broad scope of the capacity building work focuses on developing functional competencies, management & behavioral competencies, and leadership competencies in the self-help group women who are engaged in and are managing the agro-processing enterprises. The Senior Associate will work closely with the Program Manager (Capacity Building), the IMAGO India lead, IMAGO's core team, and our training implementation partners. They will also be responsible for on-field facilitation and delivery of trainings to SHG women at the agro-processing enterprise locations, in roughly 8-10 districts across Madhya Pradesh. Besides, the Senior Associate is also envisioned to work closely on strategic planning for knowledge institutionalization & sharing, IMAGO's internal team learning & capacity building. The Senior Associate will be supported in their work by the Scaling-up core team, and Program Manager (Capacity Building).

## **GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Capacity Building Senior Associate will directly work with and report to the Program Manager (Capacity Building) and the role will include the following tasks:

#### **General Program Execution**

- Support the Manager (Capacity Building) on the execution of the capacity building plan, as well as organize documentation and ensure smooth flow of information.
- Engagement of internal and external experts, and construction of highquality communication materials including idea illustration, technical reports, and presentation materials.
- Support on IMAGO's knowledge production with the expectation of authoring and co-authoring products.
- Other administrative responsibilities as assigned.

## Specific to the Project & role

- Planning, execution, and oversight of the monthly/ quarterly training & capacity building goals & plan for key stakeholders involved namely SHG women, Master trainers, Cluster level federation (SHG women's community institution), IMAGO's internal staff, State Rural Livelihood Mission (SRLM) district/ block teams
- 2. Close handholding, support, and guidance for capacity building of the agro-processing center teams (comprised of SHG women) across different locations, remotely as well as in-person.



- 3. Supporting the design and testing of training modules, assessment tools, and learning materials
- 4. On-field facilitation and delivery of trainings/ workshops to the SHG women at the agro-processing enterprise locations, in roughly 8-10 districts across three states, as per the training plan.
- 5. Regular engagement with the agro-processing enterprise teams, for planning and executing the specific training programmes in the respective block/ district.
- 6. Liaising with our training partners and experts for co-creation, coordination, and execution of specific capacity building modules on-field
- 7. Strategic planning on institutionalization and dissemination of knowledge and
  - learnings across the key stakeholders including IMAGO's internal team
- 8. Identifying potential training partners and capacity building partnership opportunities with suitably aligned institutions/ organizations.
- 9. Mapping of, and co-ordination with the Technical Support Agencies for capacity building, best practices in agro-processing.
- 10. Identify and document best practices in adult learning, leadership development, and capacity building
- 11. Ensure smooth implementation with close attention to measurement and documentation of learnings at each iteration.
- 12. Undertake additional tasks and responsibilities as assigned by the reporting manager or organizational leadership, aligned with the role's objectives and the organization's priorities.

# **QUALIFICATIONS**

This is a position at IMAGO based out of Madhya Pradesh, with at least 40% of travel requirement, mostly within the state to the different project locations.

- 3 to 4 years of overall work experience, with demonstrated experience of at least 2 years of working on learning & development, capacity building, preferably of grassroots organizations/ women-led community

- Demonstrated experience of applied structured & creative thinking, stakeholder/ people management, timely execution of tasks in a multi-stakeholder environment
- Experience in training design, workshop delivery & facilitation, learning content development, preferably (but not mandatorily) for rural communities. Eagerness and comfort in communicating and interacting with multiple stakeholders.
- Proven experience of leading professional staff and building their initiative and ability to thrive as members of efficient and effective teams
- Fluent in Hindi
